

Animal Regulation

PET REGULATION

1. We remember that by law the dog's owner is always responsible for his own animal's well-being and control; he is responsible both civilly and criminally for damages or injuries that his own animal causes to people, other animals or things inside Le Mimose Holiday Village.
2. Animal presence must be reported mandatorily at the moment of the booking and then confirmed at the arrival.
3. Animals' health documents must be shown if requested by the Director.
4. The law places the obligation in order to use always and everywhere the leash of a size not exceeding 1,50 meters as well as to bring always the muzzle (stiff or soft) so that it can be put on in case of potential danger. In addition, there is the obligation to entrust one's own animal only to people who are able to lead it. Therefore, all dogs must not move freely inside the Village; they always must be kept on the leash. As for dogs included in the category known as "biting dogs" the muzzle must be put on mandatorily; anyhow, dog and animal breeds considered dangerous, or reported as such by competent authorities, can be moved away from the Village at the Director's discretion.
5. Anyone who leads a dog is obliged to collect its faeces as well as to bring tools suitable for faeces collection. At about 200 meters from the Village the Municipality of Porto Sant'Elpidio has created a common area equipped and fenced for your animals' entertainment.
6. Dogs, as required by municipal regulation, are allowed to enter the beach only in the last row of beach umbrellas. The dog must be kept always on the leash under the beach umbrella; particularly, in no case the owner can lead the dog on the shoreline or in the sea. Dogs' owners must bring system suitable for faeces collection that, in no case, can be left on the beach.
7. Dog access is forbidden: in the playground, in the swimming pool and in the campsite's toilets, except for the "Dog Shower Point".
8. Animals are NOT allowed in the following accommodation: I Portici, Smart Rooms and Mobil Homes.
9. It is forbidden to leave animals unattended and alone inside housing units or in pitches. Animals' owners must watch over them and make sure that they do not approach other guests' structures causing annoyance; especially, a particular attention is required to cats' owners, so that their own animals do not leave their accommodation.
10. Noisy dogs which growl or bark, dogs and cats which make faeces in other people's accommodation will not be allowed to stay in the Village.
11. The Director has the right to estrange from the Village anyone who does not respect this regulation.
12. Guide dogs for blind people are exempt from this regulation.
